GULF COAST HUMANE SOCIETY 2012 YEAR IN REVIEW

Fort Myers, Florida, 01/17/2013-The Gulf Coast Humane Society had a total of 1,004 pet adoptions in 2012. The Gulf Coast Humane Society located at 2010 Arcadia Street, Fort Myers, takes in over 1,000 dogs and cats annually through Owners Surrenders and transfer from other agencies.

During 2012 Gulf Coast Humane Society proudly reduced the Average Length of Stay from 26 days in 2011, to 10 days in 2012, for our shelter pet residents. The goal for 2013 at the Gulf Coast Humane Society is to continue to find Forever Homes for our Longest Term Residents and senior pets.

The Gulf Coast Humane Society is a private 501(c)(3) not-for-profit animal welfare organization that receives no federal, state, or county funding and no funding from the Humane Society of the United States, and relies solely on donations, grants, bequests and fundraising events to further its mission of caring for the unwanted, neglected and abandoned animals of Southwest Florida. GCHS is a no-kill shelter and does not euthanize any animal for lack of space or length of time that they are in our care.
