CAT MONTH AT GCHS CLINIC

FORT MYERS, FL. – May, 27, 2015 – The clinic at Gulf Coast Humane Society (GCHS) will be celebrating Adopt a Shelter Cat Month with a five dollar discount on cat rabies shots. All cats, dogs and ferrets, four months of age or older, that live in Lee County for at least 30 days per year must be vaccinated against rabies and licensed by Lee County. The clinic will also have a free nail trim with any cat that is scheduled for surgery during June. All appointments must be placed and seen in the month of June.

The clinic has introduced their own private brand labeled products for sale to help pet owners. A Krill Oil Shed Free Soft Chew Treat is available to help with shedding, itchy skin as well improve their pet's coat.
