CAT PROMOTION FOR ADOPT A CAT MONTH

FORT MYERS, FL. – May 25, 2016 – The Gulf Coast Humane Society (GCHS) will be celebrating National Adopt A Shelter Cat month during the entire month of June by spotlighting special cats that are up for adoption.

Those interested in adopting multiple cats that are one year or older have the option of taking advantage of special adoption pricing. Cats that have been in the shelter long term (9 months or longer) will be available for foster before adopting to ensure it is the perfect fit for both the cat and owner. There will also be an opportunity to win a gift basket for those who adopt a cat during the month of June.

Gulf Coast Humane Society, located at 2010 Arcadia Street in Fort Myers, was established as the first non-profit animal welfare organization in southwest Florida in 1947. The 501(c)(3) mission is to rescue, provide safe refuge and compassionate care, and find forever homes for abandoned and neglected animals in the area. GCHS only takes in owner surrender and transfers from other shelters and rescue groups with a high success rate of adoptions. Their veterinary clinic offers a full array of affordable services six days a week and the low cost, high quality affordable spay/neuter clinic is open four days a week.
