GULF COAST HUMANE SOCIETY NEW CLINIC TO OPEN AUGUST 24

FORT MYERS, Fla. – Aug. 17, 2015 – Gulf Coast Humane Society (GCHS) announces their new, expanded veterinary clinic will open on August 24. The full-service clinic will be open to the public six days a week. The GCHS staff at the new clinic will handle a variety of services, including wellness checks, dental care, vaccinations and micro chipping.

The building was gifted to GCHS by John Bruno, M.D., F.A.C.S. of Fort Myers Plastic Surgery Center and is located at 2685 Swamp Cabbage Ct. “The opportunity given by Dr. Bruno will enable the GCHS clinic to help those who need low cost, affordable health care options for their pets,” said Jennifer Galloway, executive director of GCHS.

The new location was remodeled with the help of multiple grant money that include grants awarded from the Southwest Florida Community Foundation. The clinic will serve as a veterinary office and will be able to accommodate more patients. The expanded space has four exam rooms and two doctors to serve patients. “We are excited to have an expanded facility to better help serve the community,” stated Gloria Letendre, clinic manager.

The current veterinary clinic located at 2010 Arcadia Street will become a low-cost spay and neuter clinic that will service Lee County and surrounding counties. The spay/neuter clinic will focus its efforts on the pet overpopulation problem in Southwest Florida.

Located at 2010 Arcadia Street in Fort Myers, GCHS was established as the first non-profit animal welfare organization in Southwest Florida in 1947. The mission of the 501(c)3 is to rescue, provide safe refuge, compassionate care and find forever homes for abandoned and neglected animals in the area. GCHS only takes in owner surrendered animals and transfers from other shelters and rescue groups with a high success rate of adoptions.
