GULF COAST HUMANE SOCIETY'S ROXINE'S SURGERY A SUCCESS

FORT MYERS, FL., June 21, 2013- [The Gulf Coast Humane Society's](#), 2010 Arcadia Street, Fort Myers, current [Second Chance Fund](#) , [Roxine's](#), surgery went very well yesterday, June 20, 2013 and she is back in her Foster Home to recuperate.

Roxine is an almost three year old Black Mouth Cur Mix had two torn Cruciates in her rear legs and was in need of surgery to repair both legs. With a discount from [Dr. Eisele,DVM](#), with [Specialist in Veterinary Surgery](#), Roxine's surgery cost \$2,850, an amount raised entirely via donations, in over one week.

About Roxine's surgery, Dr. Eisle stated, "Roxine had bilateral tibial tuberosity advancements performed yesterday to treat ruptured ACLs. This procedure was adapted from a surgery performed in people. Surgery went very well and she is weight-bearing in the pelvic limbs today. We plan to start physical rehabilitation with Roxine in the underwater treadmill after suture removal. We hope to have her running, jumping and playing again in 2-3 months."
